The medical surgical department team includes, Hospitalists, Internal Medicine, Surgeons, Physician Assistants, 24/7 Respiratory Therapy services, 24/7 Critical Care Outreach Team, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapists, Speech Language Pathology, Dietician, Social Work, Unit Clerk, Personal Support Workers, and after-hours administrative supervisors, all working closely with the Program Manager.

A medium sized community remote hospital, focused on patient and family centered care, working at Brockville General Hospital offers opportunity for government funded student loan forgives program and includes a level 3 ICU, Emergency Department, Labour & Delivery, Surgical Services Department, Stroke and Rehab care, Mental Health inpatient unit as well as other outpatient clinics

The Registered Nurse is expected to maintain competence and skills through on-going participation in continuing education, including in-house BCLS and ACLS training and will be able to demonstrate proof of such participation.
